Additionally:</p> <p>Given that consent forms typically direct participants to the REB for queries about their rights, or for questions about ethical issues related to a study, participant communication may require collaboration between the REB and the institution. In a multi-centre review model, the REB of Record may not be familiar with local institutional contacts, processes or expectations for addressing participant concerns. Some participant communication may relate solely to investigator or institution responsibilities and require limited or no involvement of the REB of Record, while others may have significant ethical considerations. Thus, some organizations will designate a representative responsible for liaising and communicating with the REB of Record about participant complaints.</p>
