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Ontario Cancer Research Ethics Board N2/CAREB REB SOP Addendum

OCREB has adopted the N2/CAREB REB SOPs. However, in order to reflect specific OCREB requirements, this addendum must be used in tandem with the SOP noted below*.

N2/CAREB SOP 801 - Researcher Qualifications and Responsibilities

SOP Section	OCREB Addendum
If applicable, the Researcher must be a physician with a specialty qualification in their field and with current professional qualifications entitling them to provide health care under the applicable laws;	For clinical trials or research that is considered to be more than minimal risk, the Researcher (Centre PI) must be a physician with a specialty qualification in their field and with current professional qualifications entitling them to provide health care under the applicable laws. Additionally, There must be at least one appropriately qualified coinvestigator or subinvestigator designated and supervised by the Researcher to perform critical trial-related procedure and/or to make important trial-related decisions on the Researcher's behalf. The coinvestigator must to be listed on the site personnel delegation log;
