

INSTITUTIONS AUTHORIZING THE USE OF THE ONTARIO CANCER RESEARCH ETHICS BOARD

The Ontario Cancer Research Ethics Board (OCREB) is a central, oncology-specialized REB serving institutions in Ontario (below) that conduct multi-centre adult and pediatric cancer clinical trials. OCREB reviews research involving human participants within its established jurisdiction and in accordance with its mandate (see [ocreb.ca](http://www.ocreb.ca)).

Institutions authorize OCREB to act as their REB of Record on a study-by-study basis through a formal delegation process. In this capacity, OCREB is accountable to the institution for initial and ongoing ethics review and oversight of the research.
