REB Office Personnel must also comply with REB COI SOPs;</p>	<p>5.7.6 At the time of hire and annually, all REB Office Personnel sign a <i>Confidentiality of Information and Conflict of Interest Agreement</i> as a condition of their employment with the organization agreeing to abide by the COI and confidentiality policies of the organization. REB Office Personnel must also comply with REB COI SOPs;</p>
